## ID LOGISTICS SPAIN SWITCHES TO 100% RENEWABLE ENERGY!

THE GROUP CONFIRMS ITS AMBITIOUS PROGRAM TO REDUCE ITS ENERGY FOOTPRINT, AS PART OF ITS CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY (CSR) APPROACH.

Since April 1, 2021, 100% of ID Logistics' Spanish platforms are supplied from renewable energy sources. This initiative confirms the Group's approach to reducing its environmental footprint, and more specifically its energy footprint.

ID Logistics confirms its commitment to reducing its environmental footprint. Since April 2021, the Group has been operating on all of its supply platforms in Spain using renewable electricity.

This initiative follows the approach taken by ID Logistics in the Netherlands. Since 2020, the company has been supplying its Dutch sites only with renewable energy sources, with the same Guarantee of Origin process, both on electricity and gas.

Beyond the Guarantee of Origin Certificates, ID Logistics is working on reducing its energy footprint. The logistics operator first favours reducing its consumption. In addition to the programs implemented in all the warehouses (responsible use via presence detection, timers, etc.), one of the most direct levers is to act on the lighting of the sites and more specifically to implement LED technology. In 2019, the Group launched an ambitious program called **EnergyLID**.

This approach materializes in two ways: **for all new warehouses**, ID Logistics favours this technology by integrating it into its specifications. **For existing warehouses**, the Group is carrying out a plan to migrate lighting to LED technologies, bearing the necessary investment, if necessary. The results of this program are convincing since **80% of the sites in Poland, Spain and Benelux, 60% in France and almost 40% in Brazil are already equipped with LEDs.** These efforts have helped to reduce the energy consumed per pallet (KWh), 5.6 kWh/pal in 2017 versus 4.5 kWh/pal in 2020 (-20%). In addition, the quality of light provided by LEDs allows employees to work in better conditions.

Finally, the Group is working on the **installation of photovoltaic panels at its sites**. Thus, the next 3 warehouse programs built by ID Logistics in France will all be equipped with a roof entirely covered with photovoltaic panels, allowing these warehouses to **produce more energy than they consume**.

Javier Echenique, CEO of ID Logistics Iberia, said: « We are living in a time of transformation and social commitment and sustainable development must be one of the strategic pillars of companies. At ID Logistics, we are committed to developing our work responsibly, sustainably and respectfully of the environment and society. Thus, all the initiatives we take in terms of sustainable development are part of a set of strategic actions. Achieving these goals will only be possible with perfect coordination among all agents in the supply chain. »
