Indeed, in order to cope with strong growth, the logistician is looking for its future talents, candidates sharing the same values of the Group, such as the spirit of entrepreneurship, the desire to increase skills or agility. The different desired profiles will integrate positions of production, support function or dedicated to innovation.

#### 700 JOBS WITH SOLID DEVELOPMENT PROSPECTS

With 28,000 additional jobs in the field of transport and logistics in 2021 (OPTL figures), the supply chain is one of the most dynamic sectors for employment in France.

In this context, ID Logistics is launching a major recruitment plan for 700 new employees for 2023, including 500 permanent contracts and 200 work-study contracts. The company is looking for its future employees throughout the country, particularly in two high-stakes geographical areas: West and Paris region (Ile de France).

ID Logistics offers diversified jobs, representing all logistics functions: 450 operational positions (order pickers, forklift operators, multi-purpose logistics agents, etc...) and 50 positions of supervision (site manager, support functions).

With a majority of permanent contracts, this plan aims to offer future employees a formative and fulfilling work environment. The logistician is committed, through a comprehensive training and career management system, to grow its teams by allowing them to evolve through internal promotion.
