ID LOGISTICS REDUCES ITS ELECTRICITY CONSUMPTION BY 17% PER M2 AND SIGNS THE "ECOWATT" CHARTER FOR RESPONSIBLE ELECTRICITY CONSUMPTION OF ITS SITES

Involved for several years in a proactive approach to sustainability, ID Logistics is increasing its commitment by joining the EcoWatt system, supported by RTE, the French transport and electricity network, and ADEME, the ecological transition agency. Started on January 30, 2023, this one-year commitment makes it possible to coordinate and enrich the responsible electricity consumption actions already implemented by the logistician. ID Logistics France has already reduced its electricity consumption by 17% per m2 between 2018 and 2022.

ID LOGISTICS COMMITTED TO RESPONSIBLE CONSUMPTION

By signing the EcoWatt charter, ID Logistics demonstrates its commitment to improving electricity consumption at its logistics sites in France. It undertakes to intervene in the deployment of good practices according to network voltage peaks:

- by raising awareness among its employees and partners
Thanks to extensive work carried out prior to the signing of the charter, ID Logistics submitted a business continuity plan (BCP) and business monitoring to its partners at the end of 2022. During a voltage peak in the power grid, this BCP will ensure the continuity of operations in the event of an electrical outage ensuring data tracking. Site managers are alerted up to 24 hours before power outages, via an application. This period allows them to inform partners and collaborators and to apply the BCP.
- by relaying the EcoWatt signal to its partners.
- via actions to moderate or shift its electricity consumption.
Already aligned with many commitments common to the charter, ID Logistics has already implemented actions to reduce the electricity consumption of its sites such as shifting the charging of electrical appliances to off-peak hours, postponing the launch of activities that consume a lot of electricity outside peak periods, anticipating the drop in temperature and ventilation of unoccupied premises, etc.

ID LOGISTICS COMMITTED TO THE ECOLOGICAL TRANSITION

With an ambitious policy to reduce its energy consumption and carbon footprint, ID Logistics presented in 2021 its trajectory in terms of Social and Environmental Responsibility to 2030. The logistician has defined a roadmap of 10 objectives, including an environmental axis with the reduction of its energy intensity and waste (objective of reducing the CO₂ warehouse footprint by 40% by 2030).

ID Logistics is also committed to the decarbonization of its energy mix by offering its customers renewable energy production solutions on its sites, during calls for tenders or contract renewals.

Finally, in the summer of 2022, ID Logistics set up an internal transformation program called "WattsDown".

This program includes the implementation and monitoring of a broad plan to modernize sites in favor of energy sobriety. In this context, many actions are carried out: use of LEDs, installation of motion detectors, updating of buildings (insulation, natural light, etc.), training for employees, etc. This program contributed to the 17% reduction in electricity consumption perm², compared to 2018, and reduced emissions from logistics activities (CO₂/Pallet) by 24% in 2021, excluding compensation.

"ID Logistics is committed to an ambitious program alongside RTE and ADEME for responsible consumption. This commitment is the natural continuation of the consumption reduction efforts implemented since 2018.
