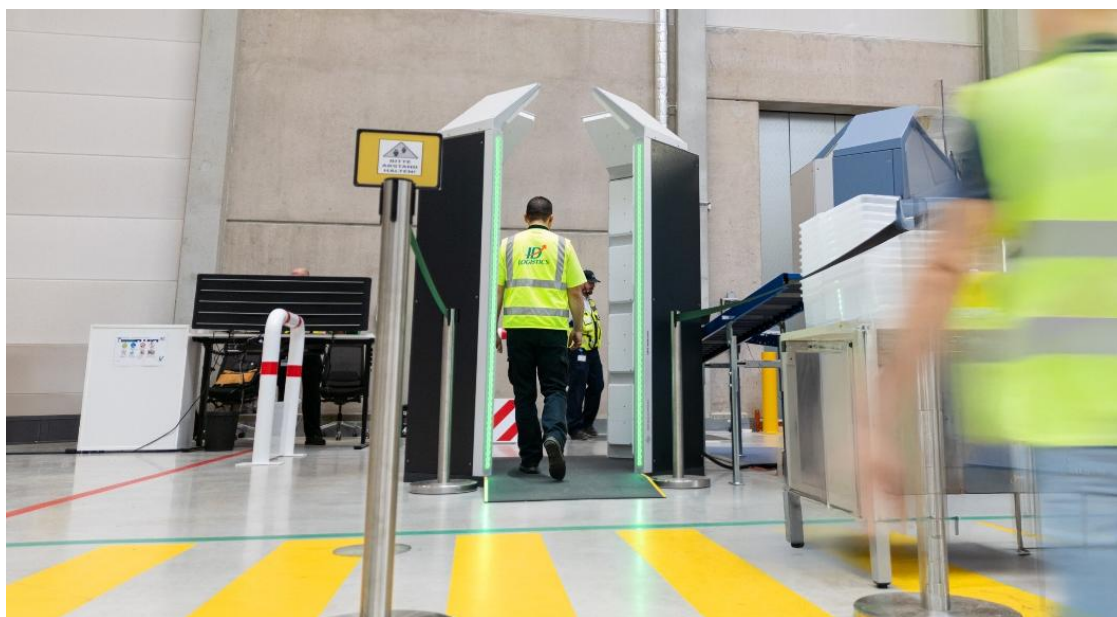

ID LOGISTICS GERMANY DEPLOYS A SMART SCANNER TO STREAMLINE EMPLOYEE ACCESS TO ITS SITES

The international contract logistics group ID Logistics continues to drive innovation in safety and service quality. The Group has become the first logistics provider in the world, outside the airport sector, to deploy the latest-generation “QPS Walk2000” scanner, developed by German manufacturer Rohde & Schwarz. This technology is currently being tested at a major e-commerce site in Germany, ahead of deployment at other locations.

A TECHNOLOGICAL INNOVATION SERVING OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCY

With this new equipment, ID Logistics Germany takes another step forward in optimizing site security and employee comfort. Using cutting-edge millimeter-wave technology, the Walk2000 enables faster, more comfortable and more reliable access controls, while maintaining a high level of safety.

Upon arriving at the warehouse, employees now pass through the scanner without stopping or removing any clothing. The system detects metallic and non-metallic objects in real time through artificial intelligence, displaying them on a gender-neutral avatar visible only to security staff.

This new device significantly reduces waiting times at site entry and exit points, especially during shift changes. As a result, controls are more accurate, less intrusive and much smoother.

ENHANCED SECURITY FOR GREATER CUSTOMER RELIABILITY

Beyond improving day-to-day comfort for employees, this new system directly enhances the reliability of operations for customers, extending ID Logistics' technological innovation to the protection of people and goods.

The Group thereby strengthens both employee safety and inventory protection, almost completely eliminating the risk of loss or theft — a key issue for sites handling high-value products.
