ID LOGISTICS BECOMES AMI PARIS' GLOBAL LOGISTICS PARTNER WITH THE OPENING OF A SITE NORTH OF PARIS

ID Logistics, a leading international contract logistics provider, announces that it will manage all global logistics operations for Ami Paris, a French luxury fashion house experiencing strong growth. This partnership, part of a transformation program launched by Ami Paris and supported by the consulting firm Mews Partners, marks a key step in supporting the brand's expansion, now distributed in more than 80 countries.

A SITE DESIGNED TO SUPPORT AMI PARIS' GROWTH

The site covers 12,783 m², including a mezzanine dedicated to unit picking and hanging garment storage. It handles wholesale, retail, e-commerce and outlet flows, and expansion capacity built into the facility.

The operation manages all Ami Paris product categories: folded ready-to-wear, hanging ready-to-wear, leather goods, accessories and footwear.

AN ORGANIZATION ALIGNED WITH HIGH END FASHION

The site operates Monday to Friday in two shifts and employs 51 team members, recruited locally as well as from the nearby ID Logistics site specializing in luxury logistics.

To streamline operations and enhance reliability, ID Logistics has implemented a fully mechanized unit picking area. B2B and B2C packing stations equipped with automatic box forming and sealing machines have also been installed, along with an end-of-line sorter, a secure hanging garment area, and full digital flow monitoring through the Reflex WMS.

This setup improves picking accuracy, shipment quality and the management of volumes during seasonal peaks. Operations are managed daily with Ami Paris through shared reporting and close governance.

TECHNOLOGIES DEDICATED TO OPERATIONAL RELIABILITY AND CONTROL

The site integrates several solutions widely used in high end fashion logistics, further strengthening operational reliability:

- Pick-to-Graphic, which displays the product image during picking to increase accuracy.
- Cubiscan, used to measure items precisely, optimize carton size and improve logistics data reliability.
- Video tracking of key workstations (packing and docks), facilitating claim management and operational analysis.

All processes — reception, storage, order preparation, quality control, returns management and shipping — are managed through Reflex, interfaced with Ami Paris' ERP and the ID Logistics TMS.

A BREEAM EXCELLENT AND BIODIVERCITY-CERTIFIED BUILDING

The site meets the most demanding environmental standards — a key consideration for a brand whose customers expect responsible logistics aligned with its positioning.

The facility includes full LED lighting, autonomous rainwater management, rooftop photovoltaic panels, preserved green areas and the reuse of demolition materials.

This environmental performance reinforces the CSR commitments of both Ami Paris and ID Logistics in reducing emissions and improving energy efficiency.
