ID LOGISTICS ACCELERATES ITS E-COMMERCE DEVELOPMENT IN BRAZIL

ID Logistics, an international contract logistics Group, is accelerating its e-commerce development in Brazil by securing three structuring projects with two major online commerce players. These new contracts represent nearly 120,000 sqm of warehouse space and the creation of more than 2,000 jobs, strengthening the Group's position in the Brazilian e-commerce market, one of the most strategic in South America.

STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS DRIVING GROWTH

ID Logistics Brazil is strengthening a strategic partnership with a leading global e-commerce player through the launch of two large-scale fulfillment sites located in Belford Roxo (State of Rio de Janeiro) and Ribeirão das Neves (State of Minas Gerais). Together, these operations add nearly 80,000 sqm of additional capacity and generate over 700 jobs.

Also in the State of Minas Gerais, ID Logistics Brazil has signed a new partnership with another major Brazilian online commerce player, representing more than 40,000 sqm of operational area and 750 jobs. This project further strengthens the Group's presence in one of the country's main logistics hubs.

Deployed under a full 3PL model covering Service Centers and XD operations, these sites illustrate the responsibility entrusted to ID Logistics in delivering fully integrated, end-to-end logistics management, from design to operational execution. The operations span the entire e-commerce supply chain and rely upon high standards of performance, reliability, and scalability.

A LOGISTICS ORGANIZATION OPERATING AT NATIONAL SCALE

Today, ID Logistics Brazil operates 72 logistics sites, representing more than 1 million sqm of warehouse space and employing 9,490 people, with the workforce reaching up to 12,000 employees during peak periods. Present in Brazil since 2003, ID Logistics relies on a well-structured logistics network fully integrated into the Group's international organization. Over the past three years, ID Logistics Brazil has more than doubled in size, supporting the ramp-up of large-scale logistics projects.

E-commerce and fashion logistics now account for approximately 49% of ID Logistics Brazil's total activity, alongside FMCG & Industry, Retail, and Fragrance & Beauty. This high-intensity segment represents one of the Group's key growth drivers in the country.

Operations are deployed across several strategic regions, including the States of São Paulo, Rio de Janeiro, Minas Gerais, Espírito Santo, as well as the Federal District. ID Logistics Brazil's headquarters is located in Barueri, in the State of São Paulo.

A KEY CONTRIBUTOR TO THE GROUP'S INTERNATIONAL STRATEGY

In the context of the growing importance of the Americas in the Group's overall growth, ID Logistics continues to expand its activities in Brazil, supported by structuring partnerships and a mature operational footprint. ID Logistics Brazil stands out as one of the Group's main growth drivers in South America, complementing the expansion underway in North America, and supporting international clients with high operational standards.
