ID Logistics awarded the “Great Prize” of the Kings of the Supply Chain event 2017

Cavaillon, 20 January 2017 - ID Logistics has been awarded, with its client Danone Eaux France, the “Great Prize” of the Kings of the Supply Chain event 2017 for its "Private rail hub" project for evian’s plant. This prestigious title was awarded at a ceremony hosted by Supply Chain Magazine on 19 January 2017 at the Salons de l’Aveyron in Paris.

Selected from the final shortlist of eight candidates, ID Logistics received the prize for an entry that best met the judges' criteria of "*originality, innovation, difficulties overcome and results*".

With encouragement from Danone Eaux France, in 2013 ID Logistics created a multi-client operational management platform named IDEO. This platform manages all European transport flows, by road and rail, for a number of clients.

To help meet evian’s target of being carbon neutral by 2020 and in order to fulfil the Evian plant's requirements of flexibility, performance and visibility, IDEO created a private rail hub.

The implementation of this project, which began in December 2015, came in several stages:

- the appointment of a Local Rail Operator, for the regular transfer of products to the Ambérieu hub, near Lyon, sorting of wagons and optimization of trains before departure across Europe. This contract was awarded to RegioRail;
- the development by IDEO of a global rail management IT system to provide better visibility on freight flows (Rail PL);
- the joint design, with start-up company Everysens, of a "connected wagon" pilot scheme using the 'internet of things', giving complete visibility on the location of the wagons in service.

"A year after coming into service the project has lived up to its promise, with more than a million pallets dispatched through the new rail hub, equivalent to 60% of the plant's total output. Danone's ambition is to further develop in this direction, in order to promote rail and multi-modal activity", commented Corentin Cavrois, European Logistics Director at Danone Eaux France.

"We are extremely proud to receive this award. First of all, I would like to thank Danone Eaux France who placed their trust in us from the very beginning of this project. This prize is a recognition of the passion of our teams who work day in, day out to provide our clients with an innovative, bespoke service, pooling resources to solve the equation of environmental impact, service quality and cost. This prize also demonstrates IDEO's ability to reinvent a global management solution meeting the needs of our clients as they seek to increase their use of this green transport option", added Emmanuel Guérin, CEO of IDEO.
