Active on the market since 2013, following the acquisition of CEPL (400 employees, 3 sites: Germersheim, Weilbach and Mittelstadt), ID Logistics has continued to develop and, as of 2019, has become one of the Top 5 service providers specializing in e-commerce.

Recognized in Germany for the quality of its services and solutions for the retail, home furnishing, e-commerce and cosmetics sectors, ID Logistics Germany now employs 3,800 people at 10 sites, covering more than 530,000 m² of warehouse space.

Initially active in the cosmetics sector with customers such as Coty, Yves Rocher and Nobilis, the company quickly established itself in the e-commerce market. For the past five years, ID Logistics has been providing e-commerce logistic support for the global furniture giant at its Dortmund site and also manages a 156,000 m² logistics platform in Salzgitter. It also supports the German e-commerce leader on several sites and offers various types of services for this customer (such as order preparation, packaging, cross-docking and distribution...).
